We plan on leaving the _____ about 11:30 AM. There are ## barns on the tour and the route is based on the best way to get a school bus down the roads, the schedules of a few of our hosts, etc. *We expect to spend about 15-20 minutes at each stop.*

A reminder:

- If you require that you or someone from your family be present when we arrive, please advise; otherwise participants will be limited to viewing and photographing the exteriors of the barn and other buildings and structures only - **no interior tour**.
- If you do not have a driveway with area that will be large enough for a school bus to enter and turn around, or have areas you do not want a school bus to enter please advise; otherwise the school bus will park on along the highway at the end of driveway for participants to get on and off the school bus.
- Please sign 'DO NOT ENTER' and close off any areas you want to keep off limits. Use yellow tape for areas without walls or fences.
- *Please do not feel the need to spruce up for our visit!* Tour participants understand about farms and old barns, and are more interested in the history and the architecture than anything else.
- If you have the time and are available, we welcome an overview of your family farm, the barn and other buildings and structures.
- If you have any photographs or other items of interest about your farm that might be of interest, feel free to display. *Please protect any photographs or items that are old or fragile.*
- If you wish, feel free to prepare a handout of the history of your family farm including the barn and other buildings and structures.
